

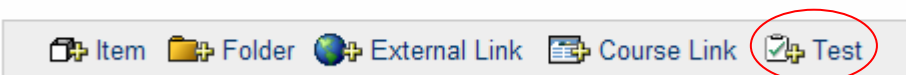
# Making Your Test Available in Blackboard 6.3

New in  
**Bb6**

In this tutorial you will learn how to make a test available to students in one of the content areas of your course.

1. In the **Control Panel** under **Content Areas**, select the content area where you want the test to appear. For the purpose of this tutorial, click on the **Assignments** link
2. On the **Assignments** page click the **Test** button on the menu bar

3. On the **Add Test** page, select the test you want to make available from the tests listed, then click the **Submit** button

## Add Test

### 1 Add Test

Create a new Test or select an existing Test. (Any Test that has already been added will not be displayed.)

### 2 Submit

Click **Submit** to add this Test. Click **Cancel** to quit.

4. On the **Modify Test** page, select the **Modify the Test options** link

5. On the **Test Options** page, scroll to the **Test Availability** section. Click **Yes** to “Make the link available”. Click Yes to “Add a new announcement for this Test” if you wish to automatically add a new announcement to the Announcements area of your course

**Allow multiple attempts.** Permit users to take this Test multiple times.

**Force Completion.** Test must be completed the first time it is launched.

**Set timer.** Set expected completion time. Selecting this option also records completion time for this Test.

**Password.** Require a password to access this Test.

6. Choose the desired options from the **Test Availability**, **Test Feedback**, and **Test Presentation** sections

**3 Test Feedback**

Feedback Mode

**Score Only**  
Only the final score is presented.

**Detailed Results**  
The user's answers, whether they are correct, and the final score are presented, but not the correct answers.

**Show Correct Answers**  
The user's answers, the correct answers, and the final score are presented, but not any question feedback.

**Detailed Results, Correct Answers, and Feedback**  
The user's answers, the correct answers, feedback for the questions, and the final score are presented.

**4 Test Presentation**

Presentation Mode

**All at Once.** Present the entire Test on one screen.

**One at a Time.** Present one question at a time.

**Prohibit Backtracking.** Prevent changing the answer to a question that has already been submitted.

**Randomize Questions.** Randomize questions for each Test attempt.

**5 Submit**

Click **Submit** to update options for this Test. Click **Cancel** to quit.

Click the **Submit** button to make your test available
